

CONTACT LIST FOR FUTURE STUDIES ABOUT PSYCHIATRIC ADVANCE DIRECTIVES BRIEF INFORMATION SHEET

- *Have you completed an advance instruction for mental health treatment?
- *Have you appointed a **health care agent to communicate your decisions** about mental health treatment?
- *Have you **helped someone else** create an advance instruction or appoint a health care agent?
- *Has somebody appointed you as a health care agent?

If you have done any of these things, we would like to talk with you!

We are researchers at Duke University School of Medicine, led by Marvin S. Swartz, MD and Jeffrey W. Swanson, PhD.

We would like to learn about people's experiences with these documents –how they work, what would help them work better, how to expand access, and other potential topics!

We are creating a Contact List of people interested in being contacted about future research.

Typically, our research projects involve an interview and compensation for your time.

Research contact lists include only people who choose to add their names to the list for possible future contact by Duke researchers about study participation.

We would like to tell you about it, so you can decide whether to add your name to the List. (If you give your permission for us to talk to you, that is not the same as giving permission to be on the official Contact List.)

Your participation in psychiatric advance directive facilitation with the Crisis Navigation Project will not be affected by your decision whether or not to be added to the Contact List.

If you decide to participate, Dr. Marvin Swartz and Dr. Jeffrey Swanson will be in charge of this Contact List. The Contact List will be kept confidential as required by law. Paper forms will be kept in a locked filing cabinet and the Contact List will be a password-protected file limited to certain users at Duke University School of Medicine. Federal privacy regulations provide safeguards for privacy, security, and authorized access. No identifiers will be disclosed outside of the Duke research team led by Dr. Swartz and Dr. Swanson.
