

Script for Crisis Navigation Project facilitators to introduce Duke Contact
List

After completing an advance instruction and/or health care power of attorney (OK if not 100% complete, but facilitator believes it will be):

Now that you have [or are about to have] a [PAD], it would be good to know how it works out for you.

Some researchers from Duke are part of the Crisis Navigation Project – they helped create the training that I took to become a facilitator. (Marvin Swartz, MD, Jeff Swanson, PhD)

They are interested in learning about people’s experiences with PADs, such as how well PADs work for people, how they get used in a crisis, and how they can be as effective as possible.

Typically, research participation involves being paid to answer questions about your experiences and attitudes.

They would like to create a Contact List so they can reach people like you, who know what it’s like to have a PAD.
